

## WINSLOW TOWNSHIP SCHOOL DISTRICT

### Pre-School thru 12 Pupil Immunization Requirements

All pupils entering or transferring into Pre-School, Kindergarten, First Grade and up, who were born on or after January 1, 1998, are required to have the following health immunizations to begin school according to New Jersey State Law on Immunizations (*Chapter 14 of the State Sanitary Code Immunization of Pupils in Schools 8:57-4.1 to 8:57-4.20*).

Children six months through 59 months of age attending any child-care center or preschool facility on or after September 1, 2008, shall annually receive at least one dose of influenza vaccine between September 1 and December 31 of each year.  |

If 4 <sup>th</sup> DTP is not on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday, then a 5 <sup>th</sup> DTP dose is required.<br>2. If 3 <sup>rd</sup> Polio is not on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday, then a 4 <sup>th</sup> Polio is required.<br>3. On or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday. *** <i>effective 9/1/2008 up to 4 days prior 1<sup>st</sup> birthday or after.</i><br>4. No less than 1 month after MMR.<br>5. On or after first birthday *** <i>effective 9/1/2008 up to 4 days prior 1<sup>st</sup> birthday or after.</i>  |
| <b>6<sup>th</sup> Grade</b>                | 4 doses DTP/DtaP or 5 doses DTP ( <i>see note 1</i> )<br>3 doses Polio or 4 polio may be needed ( <i>see note 2</i> )<br>1 dose MMR ( <i>see note 3</i> )<br>2 <sup>nd</sup> Measles ( <i>see note 4</i> )<br>3 doses of Hep B ( <i>see note 5</i> )<br>1 dose Meningococcal Vaccine ( <i>see note 6</i> )<br>1 dose Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, ancellular pertusis no earlier than 10 <sup>th</sup> birthday ( <i>see note 7</i> )) | 1. If 4 <sup>th</sup> DTP is not on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday, then a 5 <sup>th</sup> DTP dose is required.<br>2. If 3 <sup>rd</sup> Polio is not on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday, then a 4 <sup>th</sup> Polio is required.<br>3. On or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday. *** <i>effective 9/1/2008 up to 4 days prior 1<sup>st</sup> birthday or after.</i><br>4. No less than 1 month after MMR.<br>5. Unvaccinated children ages 11-15 that have not begun or completed Hep B vaccine series subject to the Grade 6 Hep B requirement can be given an approved 2 dose Hep B regimen.<br>6. Every child born on or after January 1, 1997 and entering or attending Grade Six or a comparable age level special education program with an unassigned grade on or after September 1, 2008, shall have received one dose of a meningococcal containing vaccine, such as the medically-preferred meningococcal conjugate vaccine.<br>7. Every child born on or after January 1, 1997, and entering Grade Six, or a comparable age level special education program with an unassigned grade on or after September 1, 2008 shall have received one does of Tdap. Children entering or attending Grade Six on or after September 1. 2008, who rec'd a Td booster dose less than five years prior to entry or attendance shall not be required to receive a Tdap dose until five years have elapsed from the last documented Td dose. |
| <b>9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup></b> | 4 doses DTP/DtaP or 5 doses DTP ( <i>see note 1</i> )<br>3 doses Polio or 4 polio may be needed ( <i>see note 2</i> )<br>1 dose MMR ( <i>see note 3</i> )<br>2 <sup>nd</sup> Measles ( <i>see note 4</i> )<br>3 doses of Hepatitis B ( <i>see note 5</i> )   | 1. If 4 <sup>th</sup> DTP is not on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday, then a 5 <sup>th</sup> DTP dose is required.<br>2. If 3 <sup>rd</sup> Polio is not on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday, then a 4 <sup>th</sup> Polio is required.<br>3. On or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday. *** <i>effective 9/1/2008 up to 4 days prior 1<sup>st</sup> birthday or after.</i><br>4. No less than 1 month after MMR.<br>5. Unvaccinated children ages 11-15 that have not begun or completed Hep B vaccine series subject to the Grade 6 Hep B requirement can be given an approved 2 dose Hep B regimen.   |

\*\*\*Children who present documented laboratory evidence of measles, mumps or rubella immunity are not required to receive that vaccine.

\*\*\*Varicella/Chicken Pox 1 dose of vaccine OR proof of illness, may be lab, physician or parent documentation
